

CAMP RULES

1. Shoes must be worn at all times.
2. Stay on campgrounds. (If you need to leave, please check with the camp director.)
3. Please put games and equipment away when not in use. If something breaks please let us know. We would like to be able to purchase new and not have to replace the old because someone was careless.
4. Guys stay out of, and do not hang around, girls' dorm, shower or outhouse.
5. Girls stay out of, and do not hang around, boys' dorm, shower or outhouse.
6. Water buckets in the dorm are for hot and cold water to wash up in. Water may be retrieved at the west side of the church. (If off – get water from the kitchen)
7. Campers and staff, due to health and safety, please keep out of the kitchen unless permission has been given for you to be there.
8. Toilet paper, Lysol, paper towels and drinking cups may be found at the kitchen. Please knock.
9. No phone calls unless it is an emergency. Please check with the Camp Director for permission to use the phone. Cell phones please emergency use only. I will collect them.
10. The pop can crusher is located on the bell pole. Please crush all pop cans and put in the garbage cans provided.
11. Please no food or pop, etc. in the dorms. (Unless you like the possibility of mice crawling around in your bed or suitcase.)
12. Please! Hands off of other people's belongings.
13. There is a 55 gallon drum provided to place glass and cans in by the kitchen.
14. Gum is ok but we don't want to find it on the dishes, grounds, or under things; like benches, tables, pews or anywhere else. If you're through chewing, wrap it up and put it in the trash can.
15. Bathrooms in the church basement are for girls only for putting in contacts, washing hair, etc. Do not use the toilets. Thank you! Abuse and the camp director will lock them and nobody will be able to use them.
16. Boys are not allowed to use the bathrooms in the church basement. Boys may use the restroom in the kitchen for putting in contacts only. They are not allowed to use the toilets.
17. Please attend all activities, unless excused by the nurse.
18. No personal contact. (Married couples only)
19. Turn all medications in to the camp nurse.
20. Hats off in the church at all times and in the dining hall during meal time. The camp director will collect hats if this rule is broken.
21. Please keep paper trash picked up on the grounds, Faith Hall, the dining hall, the church, etc.
22. Canteen will be open three times a day for teen camp – morning, afternoon and evening. Canteen for other camps in the afternoon unless otherwise announced.
23. Teens please lock your vehicles and stay out of them during camp unless you are going back and forth to work. You may turn your keys in to the camp director for safekeeping.
24. Enjoy your time here at camp. I hope that these rules do not have to be mentioned again.
25. No camper has ever been sent home and we hope to never have too.
